Richard's Ramble:

This month see the celebration of the Queen's jubilee. I am sure many will be involved in street parties and other events. The word 'jubilee' has its origins in the Hebrew word 'Yobel' which literally means 'rams-horn trumpet'. The reason for this is that, at the commencement of the Biblical year of jubilee, the rams horn trumpet would be blown to signal its beginning. Deuteronomy 25:10-12 says this about the year of jubilee,



Consecrate the fiftieth year and proclaim liberty throughout the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you; each of you is to return to your family property and to your own clan. The fiftieth year shall be a jubilee for you; do not sow and do not reap what grows of itself or harvest the untended vines. For it is a jubilee and is to be holy for you; eat only what is taken directly from the fields. In other words, it was a time when all debts were written off. It was also a time for a year long holiday since no sowing or reaping was to take place. Thirdly, it was a time when slaves and prisoners were set free.

When Jesus came, he proclaimed 'the favourable year of the Lord'. In other words, we live in a time of continuous jubilee. The debt of our sin has been dealt with. We do not have to work for our salvation. We are set free from the yoke of slavery to sin. In this season, give thanks for the Queen, but also give thanks to the Lord for bringing us into his year of jubilee.
