There are Nordic, German, Evangelical, and many other varieties of Lutherans and they all have their own set of churches and oversight working concurrently in this country. They all believe the same basic doctrine but are banded

together around common languages, a common history, etc. However, as I listened as they expounded the basis of their theology, I could not help but thank God for Luther once more. 90% of what we believe is only possible because Luther was willing to take his stand (he 'could do no other') against error and against the establishment of the Catholic Church. Thus, we too can say that salvation is through Christ alone, by grace alone, through faith alone, made known through scripture alone.

In the onslaught of weird and wacky doctrines (mostly from the US), may we never lose sight of these core truths and may we thank God for this man whom God used, flawed as he was, to re-establish the true foundation of our faith. *God bless, Richard*




Fundraising for: The Children's Hospital Charity
