**Richard's Ramble!** Recently Carolyn and I returned from Malta. Part of our reason for going there (other than a late season burst of sun) was to see the spot where St. Paul was shipwrecked, as recorded in Acts 27. This spot is commemorated with a cross and a statue of Paul and is on an island just off the coast of Malta. We sailed past it during a mini cruise but wanted to get a bit closer in order to take some photos. We set off on foot from the town of Melheia and after about half an hour, we came to a fork in the road. We took the left fork, the broader road, and walked for about another half hour along tracks in hilly terrain surrounded by farmer's fields. Eventually we found ourselves at a dead end still no nearer to the shipwreck spot. Retracing our steps back to the fork in the road, we took the other track. This track was less well maintained but seemed to be going in the right direction. Eventually, we found ourselves at the end of this track and still could not see the spot we were seeking. Then Carolyn pointed out a small footpath which we followed through some bushes and trees. Suddenly, we emerged into an open area and there before us was that which we had been seeking. We stopped to enjoy the sight and the views, taking some photos as we did so. As we walked back up the pathway we discussed how this whole experience was a metaphor for life. Some of us set off along the obvious track but eventually find ourselves in a dead end. The journey may have been pleasant and the views amazing, but we haven't got to where we expected to be. Sometimes it is possible to go back but at other times we may have to live with the disappointment of unachieved goals. Others off us may take the path less travelled: we know where we want to get to but may not know how



to get there. Each tentative step is a step into the unknown, but faith takes us forward. Even when we come to a point where it seems there is no way forward suddenly a new opportunity may open up that will deliver us to our goal. In all of this, there are no guarantees in life. In all of this, there are no guarantees in life. There are choices to be made along the way and none of us can determine the outcome of those decisions with absolute certainty. As a Christian, I can ask God for help with those decisions and trust that he will guide me in the right direction.
