The reality for us as Christians is that any such process promotes a mixture of emotions. We hate to see our loved ones suffer, but we also do not want to say good bye to them. On the other hand, we know that their departure will take them to a much better place - they will be in glory with the Lord awaiting the final resurrection! There is no way to trivialise the varying emotions that all this generates and the differing responses of individuals to such circumstances. We must each deal with loss in a way that is unique to us. However, this knowledge of better things to come for those who leave us gives us great hope and comfort. It also reminds us of our own mortality and our need to make every day we remain on this earth count for something.

I finish with the words of Paul from 1 Corinthians 15: 51-53: "Listen, I tell you a mystery: we will not all sleep, but we will

all be changed - in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality." God bless, Richard

faith and helping me study in a structured way. David Miller. See Richard B for further details.






We meet weekly at 6:30pm in
