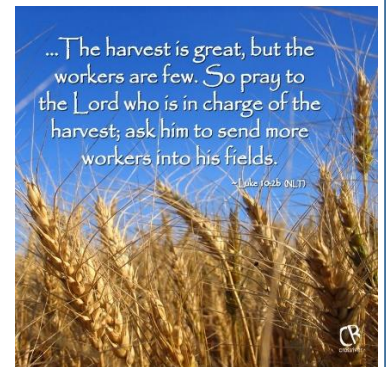


Richard's Ramble! We start the new term on the back of a One Event that was both inspirational and challenging. For me, the stand out message was delivered by Helen Azer (booked for next year's Chosen Women conference) who delivered a message that was both prophetic and motivational. If you weren't there, I am happy to lend you the DVD.

The key with such messages, and indeed such conferences, is that we do not return with a book full of notes and a head full of stuff which has evaporated by the first week of September, but that we take that which God has shown us or inspired us with and put it into action, whether that be to start a new group, to speak to our neighbours, friends or family about Jesus, or just to spend more time seeking God in the year to come. We are not called to be consumers (of messages and ministry) but producers (of that which will build the kingdom and reach the lost).

I believe there is a strong mandate upon the church in the UK to reach out beyond our buildings, be it in social action, or in evangelism. As a church, we are not passive - we are known to be a church that does stuff and that gets things done. However, we can never be complacent - there is always more that can be done. Jesus' declaration to the disciples was that 'the harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Pray the Lord of the Harvest to send out workers into the Harvest' (Matthew 9:37-38). I don't believe that is just about God raising up evangelists. We are all called to be witnesses. I believe this prayer is more about sending us all out into the harvest wherever God has called us to live and work.

This term, I would encourage you to look for the harvest wherever you are and to be God's co-worker in that place to bring that harvest into his storehouse. God bless, *Richard*.
