

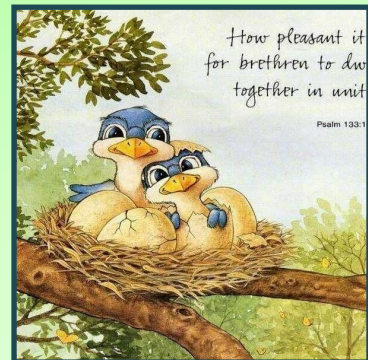
BCC News!

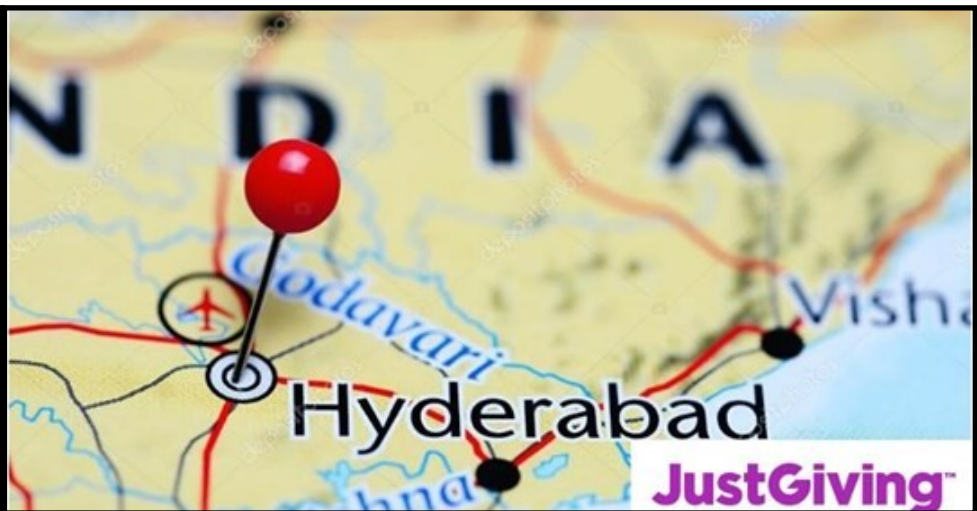
