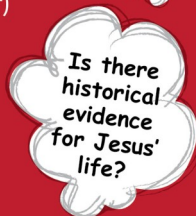

The programme is as follows:

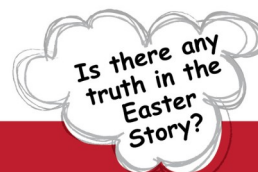
- Week 1: Is there more to life than this?
